What Nordic country did the shark go to in summer? Why?



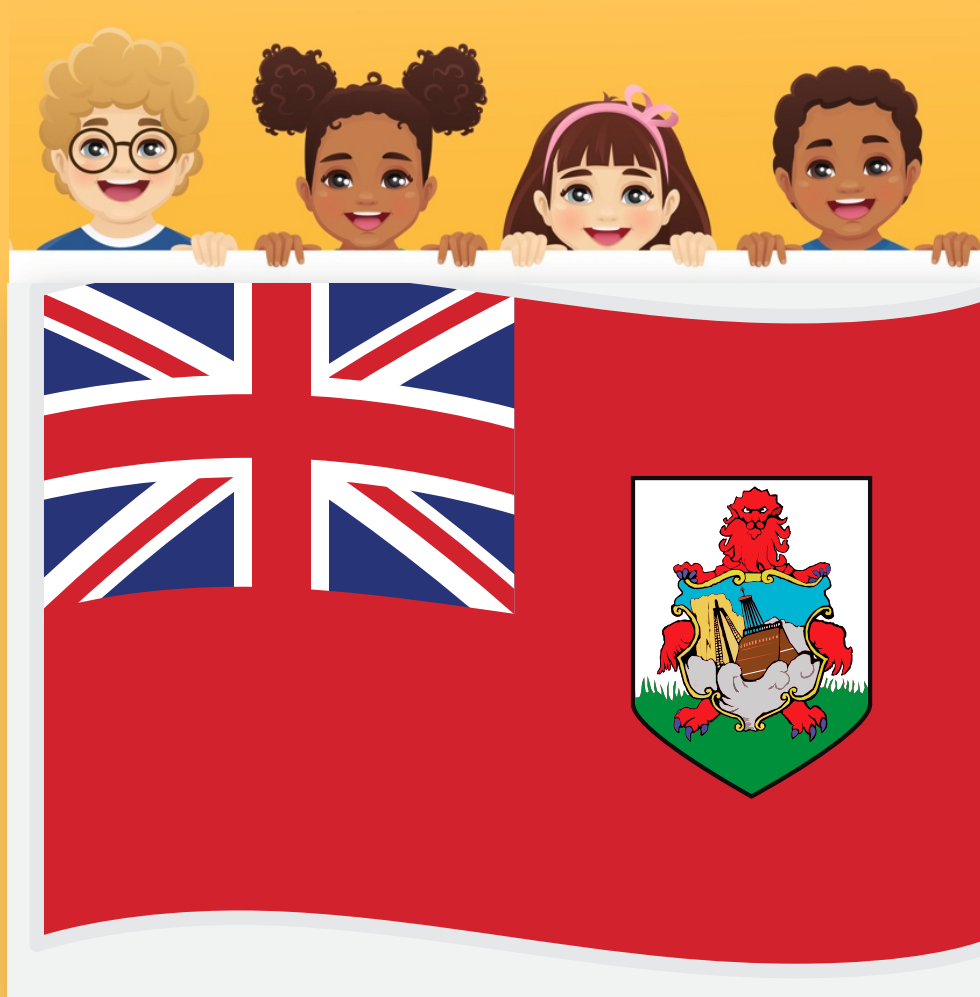

nation-state in Europe.

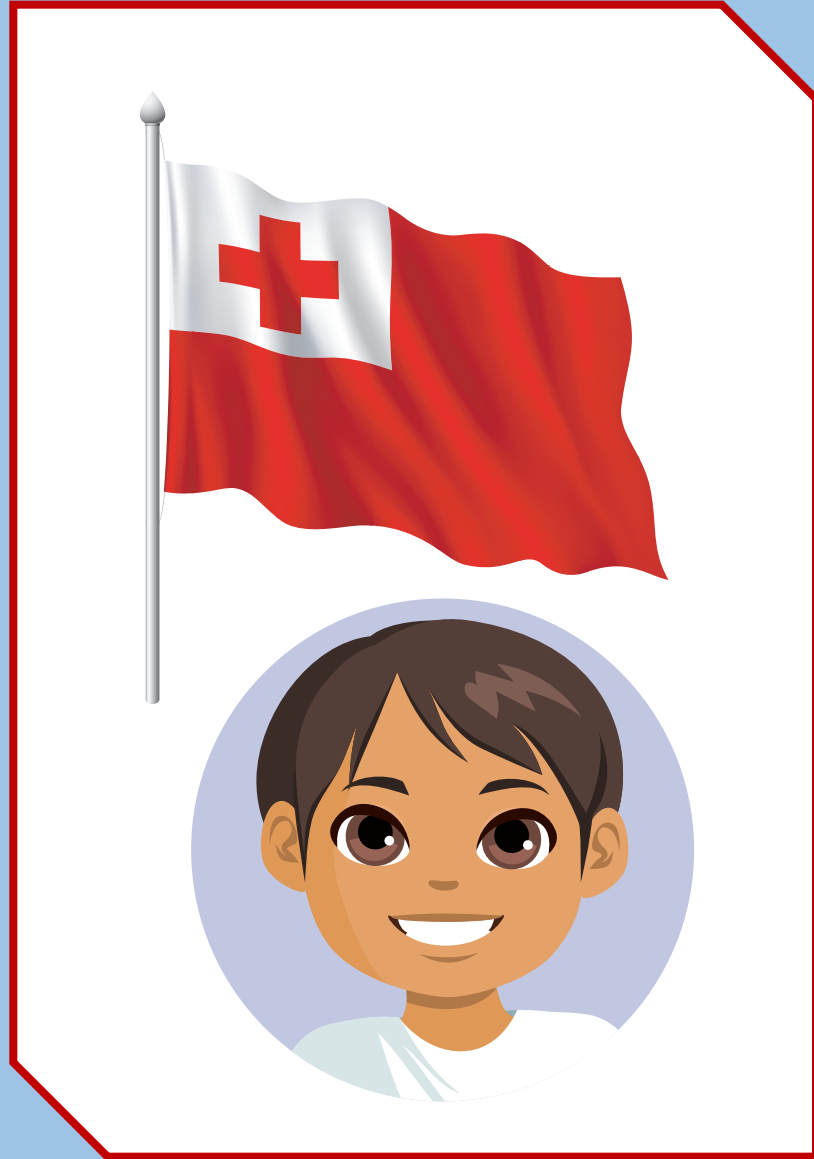
# What British island territory does Elsie the Cow go to on vacation?
